KING'S PRESCHOOL

King's Preschool is a faith-based preschool and extended care program for children ages 18 months to 5 years old. At the heart of the program is a personal love and relationship with Jesus and desire to share His love with His children. King's is committed to providing each child with a thoughtful, creative, and cooperative learning curriculum that equips them in body, mind, and spirit for God's purpose and glory. The mission of King's Preschool is to partner with families in the community to provide quality Christian early childhood education and development opportunities. Building a strong foundation in early learning is critical to a successful future in education and training in God's Word builds a strong foundation for future leaders.



KING'S ELEMENTARY

King's K-6 provides a caring environment where students grow in their faith and academically. Striving to build relationships with all students and families, King's staff is committed to fostering an environment where students feel inspired to challenge themselves. The Elementary curriculum includes activities that enrich and expand student life both on and off campus. All students have the opportunity to learn from specialists in the areas of health sciences and physical education, Spanish, technology, robotics, life skills, art and vocal and instrumental music. Through their experiences inside and outside the classroom, students develop a strong spirituality and learn how to apply their faith to practical living. We are committed to the integration of faith and learning.



KING'S JUNIOR HIGH

King's Junior High is a place where students grow. Rigorous academics, leadership training, and sportsmanship all create a structured, nurturing community where students mature beyond the elementary years and prepare for high school. Guidance from teachers is critical at this stage of a student's

life. Students and alumni point to our teachers as the reason for King's success. Teachers have proven to be exemplary role models and accredited educators who have a passion for Christian education. Though students at King's have varying levels of Biblical knowledge, the Bible is foundational to King's Junior High. This fosters an atmosphere of acceptance and compassion, creating student experiences that encourage and nurture deeper levels of Christian commitment. The King's Junior High athletic program allows student athletes to compete against other junior high and middle schools in the Puget Sound area while a superior coaching staff emphasizes skill development, teamwork and Christ-like sportsmanship.

Beginning in elementary school and culminating in high school, the King's Robotics program is thriving and is recognized as one of the best in the Northwest. The Cyberknights have brought home 4 world championships. It is exciting to see the growth in this program and look forward to see it expand in the years to come.



KING'S HIGH SCHOOL

The King's High School philosophy is to give students what they need to succeed in college and in life: academic excellence and a caring community. The standard curriculum is the highest quality college-prep track available, and offers a strong honors and Advance Placement program. Ninety-eight percent of King's High School graduates pursue college. King's blends academics with sports, music, drama, student government and more, providing many exciting opportunities for student involvement. Twothirds of King's exceptional faculty hold Masters Degrees, and all are knowledgeable, active Christians who use the Bible as the foundation for teaching students. King's High is a place where a vibrant student body engages daily with professional, Christian teachers, staff and coaches. Spiritual formation at King's High School is not a program that can be separated out from the curriculum; it's a part of everyday life. Academics, the arts, athletics, technology, and even lunch are all part of students' spiritual lives when life is approached with a Biblical worldview.

King's High School has won 40 team state championships in the past 20 years. In the classroom, King's High School has also been working very hard with 28 academic state championships since 2002. POSITION SUMMARY

The Head of School reports to the CRISTA President & COO and provides strategic Christian leadership to all programs and support systems of King's Schools. The Head of School will be thoroughly committed to the mission and vision of the school. An ideal candidate will most likely have experience as an educator and administrative leader in either Christian or public education. The candidate may also have demonstrated Christ-like skillful leadership in a church that operates a school. Ideally the candidate will have experience with academic support for a diverse range of children and will be capable of building teams and mentoring principals, faculty, and staff. The successful candidate must sense a call to Christian primary/secondary education. A network of existing connections in Seattle is a definite advantage.

The Head of School will:

- Formulate and communicate the school's vision and provide overall leadership for accomplishing that vision.
- Maintain open lines of communication and cooperative relationships with school staff, CRISTA leadership, Board advisory committee, parents, students, and the community at large.
- Oversee all school personnel, operations, curriculum, academic standards, extracurricular activities, development, marketing, admissions, and compliance with Washington State requirements.
- Carry out responsibilities within approved CRISTA philosophy, policies, procedures, programs, objectives, and budgetary allocations.
- Administer programs and services in a manner that glorifies God and for integrating the goals at schools with the overall CRISTA vision and mission.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

DUTIES

- Provide responsible leadership and support to school administrators, faculty, staff, parents, and students.
- Fulfill responsibilities as one of the CRISTA Ministry Leaders to include attending required meetings, preparing reports, making presentations, etc.
- Establish and submit annual budget for approval. Monitor and ensure budgetary compliance within King's Schools.
- Hire all certified personnel and administrators; ensure the hiring of qualified and competent staff; assign, transfer, and promote employees to serve the best interest of the school.
- > Ensure compliance with and communication of all government regulations.
- Lead in establishing future spiritual growth and development plans and projections for King's Schools (strategic planning).
 - The Head of School and School Leadership will actively and with personal conviction pursue Spiritual Renewal at King's Schools based on historical Biblical standards of faith and conduct.
 - A comprehensive Bible Curriculum that is vetted, consistent with a historical Biblical Christian Worldview, will be taught throughout every grade.
 - Determine short and long-range facility needs and oversee implementation of construction, operation, and maintenance programs.
 - Oversee the development and implementation of objectives and long-range plans for curriculum and instructional evaluation.
 - Promote donor development through partnership with Resource Advancement, King's Alumni Association, as well as parents, grandparents, and other opportunities.
 - Ensure that professional development opportunities are provided to school staff.

- Ensure continuous study and revision of curriculum guides and courses of study.
- Stay abreast of current curricular and educational thoughts, trends, and practices, as well as proposed legislation affecting schools.
- Ensure systematic performance evaluation of school personnel and initiate corrective action as necessary.
- > Evaluate and set salary for school administrators, faculty, and staff.
- Oversee the preparation of and sign teaching contracts, stipend contracts, forgivable loan requests, and annual reports to ACSI and the Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI).
- > Implement, interpret, and enforce school policies.
- Act as final recourse for families with grievances.
- > Plan and facilitate various meetings/events, including:
 - Administrative Team meetings.
 - Parent Advisory Council meetings.
 - Annual Superintendent's Christmas devotions.
 - In-service days.
 - Faculty Council meetings.
 - One-on-one reporting meetings with administrators and staff.
 - Meetings of school personnel deemed necessary for discussion of matters related to the welfare and improvement of the school.
- Attend and speak at school functions, including but not limited to Back-To-School Barbeque/Convocation, school concerts, athletic events, faculty devotions, chapels, drama productions, art/science fairs, open houses, ASB functions, and Transportation Department Drivers' Breakfast.

SPOTLIGHT: SPANISH IMMERSION

The Spanish Immersion Program is an option for students at King's Elementary School. This program gives elementary students an opportunity to complete the curriculum in a nontraditional way – by immersing them in the Spanish language and culture from kindergarten through sixth grade. Students become proficient in both Spanish and English, while learning the same curriculum content as their peers in the traditional English classrooms.



- Chaperone student trips, including but not limited to mission trips and sports tournaments.

LOCALE

EDMONDS/SHORELINE, WASHINGTON

Edmonds is one of Washington's most picturesque waterfront communities, and offers visitors a seaside ambiance and residents an appealing, smalltown feel. The City of Shoreline offers classic Puget Sound beauty and the convenience of suburban living with the attractions of nearby urban opportunities. Edmonds and Shoreline are both suburbs of Seattle with populations of 42,000 and 56,000 respectively. Both are known as two of the best places to live in Washington. These communities offers residents an urban suburban mix feel and most residents own their homes. There are a lot of restaurants, coffee shops, and parks.

ANTICIPATED SEARCH CALENDAR

It is anticipated that the top four candidates will be interviewed by the Interviewing Committee in mid-December or early-January and the finalist hired by the end of February 2021.

SEARCH AND SELECTION PROCESS

The CRISTA President/COO is charged with vetting candidates for the position and is assisted by Bruce Dingman, President of The Dingman Company, and Jeff Davis, Vice President. The Dingman Company will explore a broad network to suggest potential candidates. This thorough search will include consideration of many names and subsequent review of resumes. When appropriate, candidates will be asked to provide a thorough resume, to respond to a questionnaire, and to have a video interview with Jeff Davis. Those holding the most promise will then be interviewed in person.

Next, references and backgrounds will be checked, degrees will be verified, and an extensive candidate profile will be prepared for the interviewing committee.

The interviewing committee will initially interview the top four candidates. When a preferred candidate is identified, the candidate and spouse will participate in a final interview, as well as meet the King's Schools staff and leadership teams. Interviews will take place in December or January, with the final Head of School selection in February 2021 and start date in July 2021.
