- 6. Oversee the provision of counseling and support to the membership.
- 7. Communicate at all socio-economic and cultural levels.
- 8. Offer hospitality to our fellowship, who come from very wide ranging backgrounds.

Senegal, West Africa 2

Dakar, Senegal

Surrounded by ocean, the peninsula of Dakar is a great places for surfers, beach-goers, deep-sea fishers and divers, as well as bird-watchers, soccer fans and music lovers.

The official language is French, but the national language is Wolof.

The climate is tropical with

two seasons: the rainy season and the dry season. But we tend to think of them as 'big puddles' and 'lots of dust'.

Senegal is home to about 14 million people

(approximately the population of Illinois) in a land area of 197,000 km² (almost the size of South Dakota).

95% of the population is **Sufi Muslim** and

Senegalese citizens are rated as the eighth most religious, worldwide.

Accountability

From your last ministry position we would require a reference:

- i. from someone you reported to; and
- ii. from someone with whom you served.

We would also like references:

- iii. from your mentor; and
- iv.from someone you have mentored.

We seek your permission to independently validate your references. Please let us know if this might be a concern for you.

- c) A cover letter telling us why you think you should be our pastor
- d) Your testimony and calling
- e) Your philosophy of ministry
